As members of the Home Stretch WA Community of Practice;

- We recognise Aboriginal people have a fundamental right to selfdetermination and that Aboriginal Community Controlled Organisation are best placed to deliver community led services to Aboriginal young people and their families.
- We commit to working together in genuine partnership with young people receiving our services, and those with lived experience who support us in developing our ways of working.
- We commit to a genuine partnership between Department of Communities and Service Providers to ensure all care leavers can choose to access and benefit from the service offer.
- We commit to working together to ensure Home Stretch WA services are delivered with integrity to the service model as co-designed with young people.
- We commit to working together with courage and respect, recognising we might need to grow and adapt our ways of working to ensure young people receive the supports they need in ways that work for them.
- We commit to participating in the Home Stretch WA Working Groups with a shared focus on overcoming challenges together .
- We commit to sharing any new practice knowledge and resources we develop to all members of the Community of Practice.
- We commit to building a common and shared data set with the Community of Practice, making sure that there is transparency across the system in order to improve outcomes for young people.



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
